The community fundraising campaign for the rail trail is well under way, and 2021 was a big year with \$1.2M in government grant funding secured, an additional \$208,000 raised through private and corporate donors, and \$232,455 in CSR D Area E and District of Sicamous Economic Opportunity Funds. With two sections of the project scheduled for construction in 2022, Sicamous to Mara and Splatsin to Enderby, you too can help build the rail trail without lifting a shovel! One metre of trail surface is estimated to cost approximately \$160, and your metres matter. Donate \$160 to the project through the Shuswap Community Foundation and receive a copy of the official Rail Trail Certificate.
